Submissions

As for previous editions we expect DSAI 2026 proceedings will be published in **Springer's Communications in Computer and Information Science (CCIS)**. Submissions must adhere to the LNCS/CCIS one-column page format. Papers should not exceed 13 pages (excluding a bibliography of a maximum of 2 pages). Submissions must not have been published or be under consideration for publication elsewhere. All submissions will be judged on the basis of originality, contribution to the field, technical and presentation quality, and relevance to the conference. Each paper submission will be reviewed by at least three members of the Program Committee, who will also evaluate and select the best paper award winner.

All contributions to DSAI 2026 must be submitted electronically in PDF format. Authors should consult Springer's Instructions for Authors of Proceedings and use either the LaTeX or the Word templates. Authors are encouraged to include their ORCIDs in their papers. One author of each accepted paper must attend the conference to present it, having paid the registration fee.
